The candidates have all been very grateful to RWOP for supporting all Republican candidates and giving them an equal opportunity to meet and greet our members, gather signatures on their petitions and speak to our membership.

RWOP continues to move forward and thrive in other areas of our great club. Along with the success of our programs, our Ways & Means committee continues to offer great fundraising that gives our members the opportunity to meet, volunteer together, help inspire us and provide the main funding for our club. Our Education programs are also thriving, offering our Constitution class to refresh our memories or learn new facts that enable us to stand up and defend our great Constitution. This also helps us when we pass this information along to our friends, children and grandchildren. Our Day at the Court will give each of us an insight on how the legal system works, get to know our local judges andget to see first-hand what they deal with every day in administrating justice in our community. Our RWOP 101 class has been very beneficial to help our members understand the inner workings of our club and how each of us, whether you are a long-time member or new member, can find a place to volunteer and continue to keep RWOP the influential organization that it is today. The Right To Speak program (RTS) gives our members the opportunity to directly help our legislatures get Republican bills passed. Our Membership and Communications committees reach out to encourage our members to get their friends to join our club and keep us up to date on the events taking place in our club and how our members can participate.

Our Community Outreach program solidifies caring and concern for our community whether by helping organizations that help the needy or by our RWOP School Volunteer Program which supports our local teachers and our generous scholarship program which awards scholarships to graduating Republican Seniors from our local high schools. Due to the generosity of our members, recently, RWOP donated \$7,882 to Honor Flight. This amount has accumulated over the past several years because Honor Flight could not happen due to COVID. 




# CARING FOR AMERICA MARCH ORGANIZATION OFTHE MONTH Hospice of the Pines The Pines Foundation


We received 42 membership applications in themonth of February.






#### RWOP Constitution Workshop-UPDATE
