## Campaign Corner *by Pam Jones*

There is a lot of excitement occurring at the State level, and as Republican women, we need to stay abreast of these ongoing activities.

**SB1070 is going to the Supreme Court.** In April, a three-judge panel of the 9<sup>th</sup> U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals upheld a lower court's opinion against parts of SB1070. Now, the state of Arizona is appealing directly to the Supreme Court.

Indirectly related to SB1070, there is a non-partisan group co-chaired by a Republican and a Democrat, who are getting signatures for a recall election of state Senate President Russell Pearce. As you know, Senator Pearce is the author of SB1070. We will keep an eye on both of these developing stories.

**Testimony of Arizona Attorney General.** Arizona Attorney General Tom Horne recently testified about the Arizona border before a congressional panel in DC. Horne has sued the Obama administration alleging negligence in border enforcement and, when testifying recently, he also told Congress that the United States should designate Mexican drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations. Rep. Michael McCaul (R-Texas) has already introduced a bill calling on the Secretary of State to officially list Mexican drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations. However, in spite of this, the administration, including Homeland Security Director Napolitano, continues to insist that the border is "secure."

**Early Bid For Governor.** In May, Arizona Secretary of State Ken Bennett filed paperwork to form an exploratory committee for the 2014 gubernatorial race. Although he is getting a very early start, jumping to the head of the line before any other candidate announces, Bennett cannot start campaigning or raising money until January 2014. It promises to be an interesting race!

**New Speaker.** Last, but definitely not least, Yavapai County's own State Representative Andy Tobin was recently elected as Arizona's new Speaker of the House. Speaker Tobin has admirably served LD1 since 2006, and has earned several achievements over the years, including being selected as "Freshman Legislator of the Year" in 2007; and "Legislator of the Year" in 2008. He is also known for his tireless charitable fundraising, raising over \$1.5 million, for the Muscular Dystrophy Association as well as St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and UNICEF. I know all of the Republican Women of Prescott join me in a hearty and well-deserved **CONGRATULATIONS to Andy!**

## *In Allah We Trust?*

We all understand that our system of justice and laws are based on the Judeo-Christian beliefs set out by the Founders of our country. They insisted our rights come from God, not from some government. Unfortunately, Sharia law according to Allah, the basis for justice in Muslim countries, is infiltrating the United States court system. Legitimizing this rule of law in our courts will only give Islamo-fascists, a very, very patient people, yet another foothold in taking over the West.

Tolerance for Muslims is one thing; tolerating their justice system is yet a whole 'nother animal. A definition of Sharia law from the Internet states: "Sharia law is strict Islamic law, designed to guide devout Muslims in their personal and professional dealings. It has been used by the Taliban and others to justify limits on women's rights and harsh punishments, including amputation and stoning." Shariah law is characterized as a complete way of life – socially, culturally, militarily, religiously and politically.

There are cases in 23 State US Appellate Courts that include stories of Muslim American families, mostly Muslim women and children, who were asking American courts to preserve their rights and for freedom from the discriminatory and cruel laws of Sharia. When our courts then apply Sharia law in the lives of these families, and deny them equal protection, they are betraying the principles on which America was founded.

Obama's director of National Intelligence, James Clapper, said that the Muslim Brotherhood was "largely secular" and that there was "no overarching agenda, particularly in pursuit of violence, at least internationally." The Muslim Brotherhood is appearing to be the new ally of the Obama Administration to bring "democracy" to the Middle East.

In March 2011, H.R. 973 was introduced in the House. It states: "In any court created by or under Article III of the Constitution of the United States, no justice, judge, or other judicial official shall decide any issue in a case before that court in whole or in part on the authority of foreign law, except to the extent the Constitution or an Act of Congress requires the consideration of that foreign law." This bill will help to deny any recognition of Sharia law into our US courts.

Please stay informed on this bill. Call, fax and email your congressman and senators to be sure this bill passes. It is only a matter of time in dealing with those 'believers' who want nothing more than to destroy our freedoms as we know them.

These and other inspiring acts of integrity and patriotism are a reflection of the core beliefs of our values-driven nation, delivered by those willing to rise in its defense. The strength and moral fiber of America is represented in the millions of smaller, lesser known individual acts like these across our country every day. ### TENTH AMENDMENT UNDER ATTACK!

The Tenth Amendment to the US Constitution states that, “The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.”

As we look toward Washington DC, and the Obama regime, we see more and more of our freedoms being usurped. The latest outrage is that of the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB). The aircraft company, Boeing, has a plant in Washington state which is not a “Right To Work State.” Their employees are forced to belong to a union and, as such, indirectly “contribute” much of their dues to the Democrat Party. Boeing has built another facility in Charleston, South Carolina which is a “Right To Work State.” Currently, there are twenty-two “Right To Work States” in America, Arizona being one of them.

Boeing’s fastest selling aircraft is the new Dreamliner, and the company already has 800 planes on order. With unemployment at 9%, one would think that the president would be excited over the creation of 1,000 new jobs, right? *Wrong!* Because Mr. Obama and the unions are joined at the hip, the Left is doing all it can to prevent Boeing, a ‘private’ company, from doing business in South Carolina. The NLRB filed a complaint against Boeing, because in South Carolina, workers are not forced to belong to a union. We hear the Left in America complaining about companies moving their businesses overseas, and Unions are a huge reason.

SC Senator Jim DeMint wrote a letter to Mr. Obama that has been signed by 17 other senators, accusing the NLRB of intimidating companies who chose to locate in “Right To Work States.” The letter says in part, “It’s clearly outside the authority of this federal government to be threatening and bullying and trying to intimidate companies like Boeing who should have the freedom to locate their plants anywhere they want.”

A White House official maintains that the NLRB’s complaint is an “independent agency’s enforcement action.” Who elected these people to tell private industry what to do?

How will Obama come down on this issue? If the NLRB prevails, it will be just another nail in the coffin of private industry, jobs and states’ rights as we know it.
