### Happy New Year!


Kicking off 2011 is so very exciting because we have a Republican House and we have a presidential election occurring in just under two years' time! Before we move ahead though, I would like to tell you about a trip my husband and I took in early December when we visited the Reagan Presidential Library and the Nixon Presidential Library. If you have never seen these two libraries, it is well worth the trip.

The Ronald Reagan Presidential Library is located in Simi Valley, California. I must say that the library is situated on one of the most beautiful properties I have seen as it sits high on a hillside with breathtaking views. The most interesting thing we saw was Air Force One, located in the Air Force One Pavilion on the property. We had our picture taken at the entrance to the plane and used it for our annual holiday letter. This particular plane, a 707, flew several presidents and was retired at the Reagan Library. We were able to tour the plane and found it fascinating, although much smaller than expected. Even in the area for the president and First Lady, there was no bed and no shower or bathtub. We also toured the Reagan “Oval Office”, which is an exact replica of the office when Reagan was president, right down to the jar of *jelly beans* on his desk. We then saw the miniature White House, a complete replica of the White House done in miniature. It took the builder over 30 years to build and it is very accurate.

On another day, we drove down to Yorba Linda and visited the Nixon Presidential Library. While I expected to be fascinated by the Reagan Library, I have to say the Nixon Library was equally as interesting. I learned many fascinating new facts about our 37th president. For instance, did you know that Nixon argued a case before the Supreme Court? Another interesting ‘tidbit’ is that the land the Library was built on is the actual citrus farm of the Nixon family and the home where Nixon was born is still there in its original location. We toured the home that Nixon's father built and it is still in excellent condition. We also toured Marine One, the helicopter that Nixon and other presidents flew in. A sign of the ‘times’ – it was complete with ashtrays!

I encourage you to visit these two presidential libraries if you haven't already; both are fascinating reminders of our Republican heritage. Even though Reagan represents our “Beacon of Hope”, Nixon accomplished quite a bit as well, before and after Watergate. If you do plan a trip, you should visit sometime after February 2011, as all exhibits at the Reagan Library will be open and remodeled in honor of the anniversary of Ronald Reagan's 100<sup>th</sup> birthday.

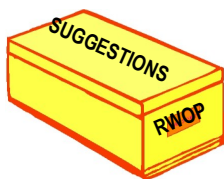
