

'Sons of Liberty' Patriot, Founding Father...and so much more

Benjamin Rush, an enthusiastic supporter of the American Revolution, was one of the Sons of Liberty and a signer of the Declaration of Independence. But there was more to this man as our fledgling country was taking shape.

He helped found five universities, led both the abolition of slavery and prison reform movements, and founded American Sunday Schools and the nation's first Bible Society having been raised a Quaker.

Rush had a major impact on the emerging American medical profession. He was committed to organizing all medical knowledge around explanatory theories, as opposed to empirical methods. He said that illnesses were the result of imbalances in the body and were caused by malfunctions in the brain. As such, he is considered one of founders of American psychiatry. He encouraged public health by promoting a clean environment and stressed the importance of personal and military hygiene.

When we think of our Founding Fathers, many times we think their only job was to form this great nation. In fact, many of these men took to returning to their livelihoods after the Revolution, just as Dr. Rush did.






