

## **Bio for Leisa Brug**

Leisa Brug is the Campaign Manager for the No on Prop 139/It Goes Too Far campaign, fighting against the abortion lobby, which is trying enshrine unrestricted abortion into the Arizona Constitution.

Previously she served as energy policy advisor to Governor Janice K. Brewer and director of the Arizona Governor's Office of Energy Policy. As a key advisor to the Governor, Leisa kept her informed on relevant statewide and national energy issues and made recommendations on executive actions and legislative proposals. In addition, she was the primary energy representative for the governor at Western Governors' Association, National Governors Association and Republican Governors Association. She also traveled statewide, nationally and internationally speaking on the Governor's behalf on energy and related technology topics.

Prior to her work in Arizona, she served as a Chief of Staff in the California Legislature and has an extensive career history in policy, crisis management, campaigns and government affairs. In 2006, she was given special recognition from President George W. Bush for her outstanding work in a nationwide policy awareness campaign. She received her education from California Polytechnic State University at San Luis Obispo, CA.

More recently, she was given recognition as a Best of the Capitol Honoree for Best Staffer and Best Grassroots Effort awarded by the Arizona Capitol Times.
