For our purposes today, we will use the term socialism to represent any tyrannical form of government.

A tyrannical form of government is one in which a government exerts oppressive power over its people.

Freedom of choice is limited or non-existent.

Rebellion is quickly and harshly shut down. It's also characterized by an elite ruling class who run society.

You're either on the "inside" or the "outside" of this elite ruling class and the quality of life is determined by one's status in society.

People have few, if any, rights as we know them.

I'm going to show you how our founding fathers were right about the nature of man and our innate behavior to abuse power.

We talk a lot about Venezuela and other socialist/communist countries and the RESULTS of it, but we haven't talked much about the CAUSE.

The really cool part is a study done at UC Bezzerkley about power.

We'll look at power in the context of today and basically show that the founders were right.

Why is this important?

Because the far left likes to claim that what was good 200+ years ago isn't relevant today. I challenge that notion.


It serves as a reminder to all of us what tyranny looks like.

After viewing this presentation, I’d like you to reread the Declaration.

You’ll see that it takes on a different meaning when you know the principles behind it.

The End of History and the Last Man
– Francis Fukuyama, 2006

This is the boring part, but you want to know this because it explains the founders' ideas. They had studied every government they knew that existed since the beginning of man and looked at why governments fail. This is important because they isolated those reasons and created a government that would avoid the same mistakes.

They also studied every philosopher over the centuries and the Bible. They especially liked John Locke's treatise.

From their studies, the founders identified 6 principles on which they based the Declaration and their design for a government.

John Locke said – “ For he that thinks absolute power purifies men's blood, and corrects the baseness of human nature, need read but the history of this, or any other age, to be convinced of the contrary.”

Whose Rights are Supreme?



So where are we? This is the basic difference. Who confers rights and where they emanate from.



I'm not implying that Hillary is a Nazi, however, the idea that "societies" rights are supreme is actually a communist platform. Hillary is a known Marxist. Her book, "It Takes a Village" was an adaptation of a college paper she wrote.

Full Disclosure – Snopes claims this comparison is false, however, it was only because they couldn't find the source. Hillary has made similar statement throughout our her public life.

In the first debate, she said the children belong to society. In the second debate, a woman can have an abortion up to the day before a baby is born.

We need to listen carefully to what they say, then look at what they do. The words are not careless or casual; they're intentional and are crafted to communicate a specific meaning.

They communicate tyranny.

What Your Professor Didn't Tell You:

Your rights are determined
by “society”, aka, the government

The work of the government is largely done
in administrative agencies

Administrative agencies hold ALL power
and are comprised of people with an agenda

Your rights are under attacked every day

Jay systematically goes through abuse of power by a number of our government agencies and how they've weaponized their powers against the American people, specifically conservatives. To want examples of tyranny in our own government, Jay's book is a great place to start.

Your Professor Didn't Want You to Know:

Bill of Rights are null and void. You have no right to:

- due process or presumption of innocence
- right to life
- right to possess guns to protect ourselves
- free speech
- free press; censorship of conservative media
- freedom of religion; controlled by government, the rise of anti-Semitism

We've learned in the last several years how the left views the bill of rights and how they'd like to replace them with a "second bill of rights". Let's go through them and give examples...



Presumption of Innocence?

Remember the Kavanaugh confirmation hearings when the socialists said that the women must be believed without proof and that there wasn't a right to due process?

And what about a right to life?

The principle American's have lived by since before the founding was that that life is sacred, and who told us that life is sacred? God

We recently learned that is no longer true for the socialists.

We've also learned that they're anti-Semitic. So our bill of rights protects our freedom of religion.

If we let a baby die under the guise of abortion, what other circumstance would they decide that it's okay to terminate a life? Under what circumstances would okay to terminate the life of a Jew, a Christian, the elderly, and other reasons?

We're already seeing speech suppressed by big tech companies, the media, on college campuses and other places. God has been added to their "suppress" list. Why? Because God represents Hope. In a socialist society, hope leads to rebellion and the socialists must maintain control at all costs or their society breaks down.

Your Professor Didn't Want You To Know the Real Purpose of Government

People can have selfish motives and some can even become violent.

We create a government (social compact) to protect the rights of all individuals, not "society's".

We give up some rights as a compromise in exchange for safety & protection so we can all enjoy our rights.

All are equal and are entitled to one vote

John Locke and other enlightened political philosophers wrote extensively about these principles. Remember, unrestrained freedom results in anarchy because without good moral character which includes discipline, society breaks down. How many of you knew that property rights includes intellectual property?

As our early societies numbers grew, we learned that alliances could be made for the betterment of all. These alliances are called social compacts. Social compacts or civil governments exist to protect the Natural Rights of all members.

We give up some rights as a compromise in order to enjoy and protect our life, liberty and (happiness) property.

In our early years, our founders passed the Northwest Ordinance to spread freedom across the land and to keep foreign powers out.

The larger the territory, the more voices would be heard and more information shared and it would produce a better outcome. It was signed July 13, 1787.

The purpose of compromise is to moderate extreme viewpoints and to come to an agreement that everyone can live with. It also creates "buy in". When everyone on a team contributes they have ownership.



Consent of the Governed

We have the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. Self-actualization = Happiness (Maslow's hierarchy of needs) The founders knew this long before the field of psychology developed.

We have an innate drive for freedom and independence. It unleashes creativity & self-expression.

Pursuing your dreams leads to feelings of happiness, contentment, feelings of well-being, satisfaction, enjoyment of what you have acquired, gratification & pleasure.

Remember the word "pleasure". We're going to talk about it again in a few minutes and what negative behavior it drives.

We know it's innate. Anyone who's raised a child has watched them assert their independence. It's part of our nature.

The “New” Social Compact

What Your Professor Said v. What He Means

1. The belief in the dignity and humanity of all people
2. A recognition that all people are connected to each other and to our living planet
3. A believe in the rights of all people to freely and fairly participate in the democratic governing structures that impact their lives



The left likes to hijack the founders' principles and rewrite them to serve their purposes.

4. A belief in the responsibility of government, markets and a civil society that works to serve the well being of people, including the right to healthcare, food, education and shelter
5. A belief that it is untenable to enact policies that suppress opportunity
6. A belief in the rights of expression under the protection of the government

A “belief” is a state or habit of mind in which trust or confidence is placed in some person or thing. That trust is placed in the government. Let’s look at what they say v. what they do.

What Your Professor Didn't Tell You:

No need for Congress to work together
because the *major work of governing* is
in the *administrative agencies*

Self-interest is the primary driver of behavior

People outside the social compact have
more rights – criminals, illegals

This hinders our enjoyment & the protection
of our families, communities and country

Administrative agencies and Commissions can be created by the Executive (President) or the Congress (in legislation) Agencies have the power of all three branches of government . In recent years, criminals, illegals, and radicalized Muslims who institute Sharia law, have been given more rights than citizens. They all fall outside the social compact by breaking our laws. It was intended that those outside the compact where not to enjoy the same rights as members, yet these agencies have ignored this.

The founders knew that they needed to protect people from those in power who would put their self-interests and ambitions ahead of the public good.



RINO's are Republican progressives. They join our party for nefarious reasons. You can identify them by looking at their voting records and their willingness to support the founder's original intent. (Originalists v. revisionists)

We have a takeover of government from within by people who don't support our Constitution through administrative agencies

The Constitution provides a means of *changing or abolishing* our form of government. Article 5 Convention of States

We used to call that treason. There are no longer consequences for bad behavior

Why Does Socialism to Fail?

To really understand it and decide if it's a viable form of government, we have to know what causes it so we can fix the cause before we adopt it.

The Big Question:



Why can't people control their ambitions for 'the greater good'?

If the socialists care so much about "We the Little People", and If man is perfecting over time. why doesn't it work?

Socialism represents the downfall of a government that can't or won't keep its people safe or protect their life, liberty, or happiness.

Instead, it steals their property, tramples their rights and devalues human life.

To understand socialism, we need to understand it in the context of our founder's view of rights and how to protect them. Let's look at recent research on power by one of the top universities in the country to decide.

The Power Paradox: How We Gain & Lose Influence

By Dacher Keltner, PhD.
Psychology, UC Berkeley, 2016

Let that sink in a minute. While the behaviors of people in government are enough to prove to a rational person that the founders were right about the nature of man and abuse of power. How can we prove it to the disbelievers? This book is about a study conducted by the Psychology Department at UC Berkeley. While they talk about power in the context of influence, the underlying thought patterns that produce actions and behaviors are the ones that pave the road to abuse of power.

What is power?

“Power is the desire in people to want to have control or influence over others that, when combined with the authority to act, can *easily* be misused.

Unbridled and unchecked, power always becomes tyrannical because the *desire to control others is innate* in many people.”

Quotes, from Dacher Keltner The crusty old founders were right. Before we had psychology...It's in our nature

Why does power corrupt?

“That’s where the paradox begins, which is that very sense of ourselves, when feeling powerful leads to...abuse of power.

“Dopamine”, the “feel good” brain chemical, makes people feel as though they can accomplish just about anything.”

Thoughts create feelings which create brain chemicals. Dopamine is a “motivator” chemical. It also is responsible for pleasurable feelings.

How does abuse of power affect the people who hold it?

People in power will take more than their “fair” share.

People become more unethical, thinking that unethical behavior is okay.

They think they’re entitled to special treatment or that their cause is for the “greater good”.

1 of 2 This is how they justify their behavior.

“It’s just this paradoxical quality of power, which is, the good in human nature gets us power, and then (abuse of power) leads to the bad in human nature.”

Powerful people feel entitled to what they take.



There’s a fascinating “cookie study”. The person in charge always felt entitled to the “extra” cooking. Many interesting studies in Dr. Keltner’s book. You can search for his articles and read about this.

What can we do to prevent the abuse of power?

Studies are finding that you make people feel accountable or let them know that they are being scrutinized, and they become more ethical. “If I’m simply aware that other people are going to know of my actions, I act in a much more ethical fashion. I avoid the abuses of power.”

Who are they accountable to? Without accountability to “We the People”, there’s no recourse if your rights are violated. Do they avoid abuses of power or do work to hide it? FISA abuses are very telling.

We the People and the other two branches of government.

Scrutinized – This was intended to be the role of the media. The watchdogs of government.

Also, it’s the purpose of open meeting laws. And we could name others.

“Another way, is to set up the system (of government) to produce the result you seek and set impermeable boundaries.

Create positive incentives around things that people desire.

Establish consequences that are meaningful for overreach.”

Our founders created the Separation of Powers & Three Co-Equal Branches of government to protect us. Each branch is accountable to the other two and to We the People. Re-election and impeachment are the powers of the people and the consequences.

And we can...Re-Elect President Trump and send a team to help him.

In Summary:

- Power leads to lack of empathy & diminished morality
- Power leads to self-servicing, impulsive behavior
- Power leads to incivility & disrespect
- Power leads to feeling exceptional

Do you think any of this applies to the the people who participated in the FISA abuses? What about others in our government?

What Happens When Socialists Control the Economy?



Now let's talk about what happens when socialists control the economic engine of a country.

When socialism controls the economic engine of a country, instead of letting free markets determine supply and demand, the socialist government creates imbalances with its interference.

The imbalance leads to shortages, inflation and, eventually, can result in total economic collapse.

Socialism exists to create wealth for the ruling elites and their supporters.

As we've learned from those who abuse power, there is an arrogance where they assume that what they're doing is "morally" right.

Milton Friedman on Greed on the Phil Donanue Show

“A government can’t control the economy without controlling people. And they know when a government sets out to do that, it must use force and coercion to achieve its purpose. They also knew, those Founding Fathers, that outside of its legitimate functions, government does nothing as well or as economically as the private sector of the economy.” - Ronald Reagan

That’s because the socialists have a very different agenda.

The government uses the economy to promote its goals by what it buys and from whom, controlling access to and regulating every aspect of our lives through administrative agencies




Agencies Control Our Businesses & Our Lives:

 - Sustainability development (UN Agenda 2030)


...and thereby controlling you!

There are over 150 administrative agencies and commission run by unelected, unaccountable officials.



UN Sustainable Development 17 Goals based on FDR's second bill of rights. "The definition of fascism," Benito Mussolini once stated, "is the marriage of corporation and state." He also said, "Fascism should more appropriately be called Corporatism because it is a merger of state and corporate power."

What you need to know is how this all links together. The UN is the epicenter of global communism. They're connected to progressive corporations, the US being the leader of global progressive business. (See *Shifring Towards a Progressive Company*) Wealthy progressive businessman/women (think Amazon, Facebook, Google, etc.) set up non-profit organizations whose purpose is to implement socialism. While they have many organizations that are involved in extensive projects (See startguide.org), one important use of their funds is make grants to universities to conduct studies. The research is skewed to support the objectives of the non-profits. That research is used by the administrative agencies and commissions to promulgate regulations. It's also used in congressional testimony in committee hearings.



The goal is to implement a global democratic socialism. Here's why everyone needs to be leery of the word "Democracy". Here are two examples: National Popular Vote is a direct assault on our Republic. Colorado and New Mexico passed legislation this year. That makes 15 state and D.C. Out of 270 electoral votes only 81 are needed to implement NPV. It will be challenged in the courts, but that's no guarantee that it will be stopped.

Tyranny of the majority – it only takes 51% to enslave the other 49%. Under this scenario, where do you think you tax dollars will be spent?

This is why we have a Constitutional Republic – a representative democracy – because pure democracy becomes tyrannical without protections for the minority voice.

We've already looked at the many levels of representatives we have – Federal, State and Local. If you'd like to see the result of one party rule, just look at California. It was achieved by attacking California's election process and the voting laws, assuring democratic socialist rule of the state indefinitely. Now the rural areas, who are in the minority, have trouble getting enough water for their crops. They either don't understand how farming works or it's another way to control people by reducing the food supply which raises prices.

We're using LegiScan to monitor legislation. We can be activists from our living rooms. No need to leave the house!

We're also looking at socialist funding of non-profit Foundations to see what they're funding. That tells us where they want to take the country and we're using email, social media and other forms of communication to reach people.
