Her passion for bringing awareness about the reality of sex trafficking, as well as healing and restoration for survivors came directly out of her own story of surviving a traumatic sexual violence rape and assault, as well as a music video she and her husband produced in 2012 to one of her original songs, 'Where Has Love Gone?' (now at 435,000 YouTube views), which re-created a scenario of young girls being trafficked here in the U.S., for which she received the International Awareness Film Festival's 2015 Best Music Video Award.*

*Lisa is the recipient of numerous other awards including Gold Album of The Year at both the 2023 & the 2020 International Singer Songwriter Awards 2023 David Film Festival (Film Freeway) for Best Music Composer and Sound Design for her album Vapors In The Wind, and the 2023 Marquis Who's Who in America for her advocacy on behalf of human trafficking victims.*

*Through her annual Evening of Destiny benefit concerts, Lisa has shed the light on this difficult reality with a message of hope to thousands of people, by bringing together inspiring original music with truth shared by local and state government leaders, law enforcement and survivors sharing their stories, that leaves people inspired to be part of the solution.*

*David and Lisa Mitts established the 501C-3 Destiny House Restoration Center in 2012 for a two fold mission:(1) education, awareness and prevention of trafficking for local communities, and (2) healing and restorative treatment for survivors in the U.S. through their H.E.A.R.T.S. program (Healing, Education & Restorative Treatment for Survivors), which serves the outpatient Holistic Aftercare Program, incorporating proven holistic therapies, such as acupuncture, cognitive function development technique, music and art, as well as individual and family counseling for releasing trauma and restoring identity and purpose*
