

Steve is a conservative businessman. He was born and raised in New York. He and his wife, Dorothy, met at Harvard Business School 42 years ago. After graduating, they moved to Arizona and have lived here ever since. They have three adult children, all of whom live in the Phoenix metro area.

Steve started his business career in corporate turnarounds. In 1988 he bought a small printing company and grew it to 350 employees with plants in Denver, Phoenix and Los Angeles. He still owns a plant in LA, and has a number of other business interests.

In 2018, Steve took on the establishment, challenging incumbent Michelle Reagan for the Republican Party nomination for Secretary of State. His campaign focused on election integrity, winning the nomination by a two-to-one margin.

In 2019, Steve founded Fair Maps Arizona, a non-profit organization focused on redistricting. The organization has mobilized thousands of grassroots activists to hold the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission accountable to produce fair district boundaries for all Arizonans.

In 2021, Steve declared his candidacy for Governor of Arizona – once again challenging establishment Republican candidates. His campaign is focused on grassroots participation, and on solving tough issues that the Arizona Swamp has failed to address.
